Students failing to satisfy the Sem 1 benchmark by 5pm on Friday, Jan. 13, 2017, will be required to make up the Sem 1 requirement in night school at a cost of \$70. Students failing to satisfy the Sem 2 benchmark by 5pm on Friday, June 9, 2017, will not be promoted to the next grade level unless hours are made up in summer school at a cost of \$70.

### College Exploration Guidelines:

College exploration may be performed ONLY at an event or activity **led by an official collegiate representative from an accredited four-year university or college**, e.g., campus tours, information sessions, panels, lectures, 1-on-1 conversations with admissions counselors, etc. There is no pre-approved site list or other advance approval requirement; however, if unsure, always check with the Dean of Students Office **BEFORE** going. **Credit will not be given for attending the same event/campus more than once or for attending a community college.** Hours that are not performed according to the above criteria will not be accepted! Be advised: College exploration hours are NOT valid if completed while classes are in session and/or during school-day hours in which the student is suspended. This includes detention.

### The College Exploration Process:

1. Arrange to attend the exploration event or activity or sign up for a school-sponsored trip.
2. Pick up as many *College Exploration Documentation Forms* outside room 110 as needed.
3. Attend the exploration service as arranged.
4. A minimum of **THIRTY MINUTES** of exploration must be performed per visit/event to receive credit.
5. If completed hours exceed maximum number for specific school you will need to see DOS office.
6. Complete ONE form per exploration. **Multiple explorations on the same form will NOT be accepted.**
7. Complete the General Information and Exploration Reflections sections.
8. University Representative must sign and date Exploration Details section.
9. "Satisfying" the exploration requirement includes returning this form *within seven calendar days of exploration* (even if the seventh day falls on a weekend). **Credit will not be given for forms submitted after seven days of exploration. It is YOUR responsibility to submit completed form; extensions will NOT be given for failure to do so.**
10. Student MUST complete the *College Exploration Documentation Form* to receive credit for exploration hours. **A letter from the university rep verifying student attendance does NOT take the place of this form!**

### UPDATES:

1. Students CANNOT attend the same college or university more than once in a school year.
2. Please see Ms. Martinez for a special form BEFORE you attend an overnight stay at a college or University.
3. Transportation DOES NOT count toward total number of hours of a visit.
